Note to All Volunteers:

- Our shelter asks that you commit to working one shift (3 hours) each week if possible. Volunteers in good standing may stay as long as they'd like while an employee or supervising volunteer is present. Any volunteer under the age of **16**, must be accompanied by a parent or guardian for a minimum of 3 months. After this period an employee or supervising volunteer will assess his or her ability to work independently, if between the ages of **13-16**. Signed parental consent will be required for volunteers under the age of **18**. No child under the age of **5** may volunteer due to safety concerns; however he or she may participate in toddler activities. Children between the ages of **5-12** may participate in our Jr. Volunteer activities.

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- ✓ *Here at our shelter, we can always use help with anything and everything! From giving baths to cleaning the facility and helping with events and transports we will never turn down a helping hand. Please review the following areas of service and check the ones you would like to participate in.*
- ✓ *For our **DOG WALKING VOLUNTEERS** - please discuss the times of the day that are best to volunteer to walk. After 4pm we would like to be tucking all our babies in for the evening and walking after this time can get everyone slightly worked up ☺.*

___ **DOG WALKING-** Walk dogs around the shelter in the grassy areas or use an open pen to play, exercise, and socialize. You will be given a copy of our dog walking rules. This increases the adoptability of our babies.

___ **KENNEL ASSISTANCE-** Feeding and watering all dogs/and cleaning kennel area. This is imperative to provide an excellent quality of life for all shelter dogs.

___ **CAT/KITTEN ROOMS-** Feeding and watering all cats/ and cleaning their cages. Again, this is imperative to provide an excellent quality of life for all shelter cats. You may also work on socializing them.

___ **ADOPTION CONSELOR-** Assist the public visiting the animal shelter by answering questions and in filling out the adoption contract. This role plays a huge part in making sure families get the pet that is best suited for their lifestyle. You may also volunteer to take digital photos and upload to social media with stories on each shelter baby in efforts to increase adoptions.

___ **EVENTS ASSISTANCE-** Participate in community events in the Shoals area promoting the FLAS and scheduled adoption/fundraiser events.

___ **GENERAL CLEANING-** Laundry, Dishes, and weekly tasks. This covers general cleaning of all the different areas of the shelter.

___ **YARD WORK-** Cutting and weed-eating the grass and maintaining outside fences.

___ **TRANSPORT TEAM-** Help FLAS with the transfer of animals to our placement partners throughout the United States and using your own vehicle to transport animals to other shelters and/or rescue groups on an on-call basis.

___ **FOSTER CARE-** Provide a temporary home to animals who need a bit of time and extra TLC before being made available for adoption and going to their new homes. This may include short term fosters already scheduled for rescue or a mamma and kittens that need a foster until kittens are old enough for adoption. Foster scenarios may differ.

___ **VOLUNTEER PROGRAM ASSISTANCE-** Provide administrative support to the volunteer program at FLAS with data entry, filing, and paperwork support.

- ___ ADOPTION PACKETS-** Put together adoption packets for events.
- ___ SOCIALIZE KITTENS AND PUPPIES-** Playing with the puppies and kittens at the shelter helps to socialize them and increase their adoptability.
- ___ READ TO THE DOGS-** We welcome our Jr. Volunteers to bring their favorite book and we will set you up with a pet to read to.
- ___ BATHING-** We always have pets that could use a little “freshening up” and who doesn’t like loving on a squeaky clean puppy!?
