Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA)
Emergency Solutions Grant Program**

The City of Florence anticipates receiving funding from the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs for service providers in Lauderdale, Colbert, Franklin, Marion, Winston, and Lawrence counties.

Eligible activities under the grant include: street outreach, upgrade existing homeless facilities and domestic abuse shelters, to help meet the operating costs of such facilities, to provide essential services (such as health and mental health services) to both sheltered and unsheltered homeless persons, to help prevent homelessness, to rapidly re-house homeless persons and to assist in the costs of administering the Homeless Management Information System.

Agencies must return the attached application by 5:00pm on Friday, May 6th, 2022.
